- Sunrise over Kanchenjunga from the legendary Tiger Hill
- Visit the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute and Padmaja Naidu Zoological Park
- Tenzing Rock and the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Centre
- Ghoom Monastery and the Japanese Peace Pagoda
- Day excursion to the tranquil Mirik Lake with boating and horse riding
- Leisurely walks amid Darjeeling's tea gardens and colonial charm

Wrapped in mist and memory, Darjeeling is the queen of the eastern hills, famous for its tea gardens, colonial-era charm and the legendary sunrise over Kanchenjunga from Tiger Hill. This 3-night circuit is built entirely around Darjeeling, combining an early sunrise excursion, a heritage-packed city tour and a relaxed day trip to the scenic Mirik Lake, making it an ideal short getaway for couples and families alike.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Detailed Itinerary

01

Day 1 — Arrival and Transfer to Darjeeling

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On arrival at New Jalpaiguri Railway Station (NJP) or Bagdogra Airport (IXB), our representative will receive you and assist with the transfer to Darjeeling, nearly 115 km and approximately 3 to 4 hours by road. Check into your hotel and spend the remainder of the day at leisure. Overnight stay in Darjeeling.

02

Day 2 — Darjeeling Sightseeing Tour

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Rise early for a 4 AM visit to Tiger Hill to witness the spectacular sunrise over the Kanchenjunga range, subject to availability of an entry permit or token, then return to the hotel. After breakfast, set out at 8:30 AM for a city tour covering the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park (closed Thursdays), Tenzing Rock, the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Centre (closed Sundays), a tea garden (outer view), the Japanese Temple and Ghoom Monastery. Overnight stay in Darjeeling.

03

Day 3 — Excursion to Mirik Lake

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After breakfast, head out on an excursion to the picturesque Mirik Lake, where you may enjoy boating and horse riding at your own cost. En route, you can also visit the Nepal Pashupati Market, using a Nepal-registered cab at additional cost for this stretch. Return to Darjeeling by evening. Overnight stay in Darjeeling.

04

Day 4 — Departure from Darjeeling

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After breakfast, transfer out to New Jalpaiguri Railway Station (NJP) or Bagdogra Airport (IXB) for your onward journey.

Visa & Documentation

This is a domestic Indian itinerary; Indian nationals require only a valid government photo ID. Each traveller must carry an original ID (passport, voter ID or driving licence), passport-size photographs, and photocopies of the ID, as these may be required for permit or checkpoint formalities en route.

Payment Terms

- 50% advance at the time of booking confirmation
- Balance 50% due 15 days prior to travel date
- Payments accepted via bank transfer / UPI / card

Cancellation Policy

- Boating, horse riding at Mirik Lake and the Nepal cab for Pashupati Market are at guests' own cost
- Each traveller must carry an original photo ID plus photographs and photocopies
- Rooms are subject to availability at the time of confirmation
