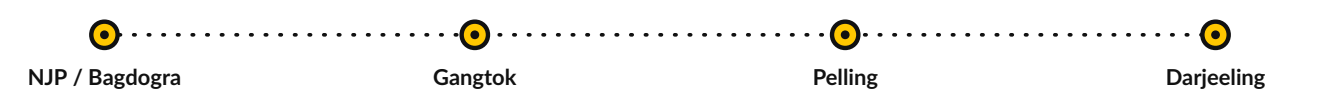

- Tsomgo Lake & the sacred Baba Harbhajan Singh Mandir
- Optional excursion to the restricted Nathula Pass
- Gangtok city tour – Flower Show, Do-drul Chorten & Bakthang Falls
- Pelling sightseeing – Rimbi Falls, Khecheopalri Lake & Pemayangtse Monastery
- Pelling Skywalk & Rabdantse Ruins viewpoint
- Sunrise over Kanchenjunga from Tiger Hill & Darjeeling heritage sightseeing

A classic West & East Sikkim circuit that pairs Gangtok's monasteries and glacial lakes with the dramatic mountain vistas of Pelling before concluding in Darjeeling's colonial hill station. Along the way, discover the turquoise Tsomgo Lake, Pelling's cascading waterfalls and the glass-floored Skywalk with sweeping Kanchenjunga views, and Darjeeling's legendary sunrise from Tiger Hill – a well-rounded 7-day journey through Sikkim and North Bengal's finest hill destinations.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Detailed Itinerary

01

Day 1 — Arrival & Transfer to Gangtok

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On arrival at New Jalpaiguri Railway Station (NJP) or Bagdogra Airport (IXB), you will be welcomed by our representative and transferred to Gangtok. Check into the hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay in Gangtok.

02

Day 2 — Excursion to Tsomgo Lake & Baba Mandir

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After breakfast, set off on an excursion to Tsomgo Lake and Baba Mandir, roughly 40 km and a 2-hour drive away. Tsomgo Lake sits at an elevation of 3753m / 12,310ft, is oval-shaped and nearly 50 feet deep, and remains snow-covered for much of the year — home to Brahminy ducks and numerous migratory birds. A further 12 km brings you to the revered Baba Harbhajan Singh Mandir. Return to Gangtok for an overnight stay. Optional: Nathula Pass excursion available at additional cost, restricted-area permits and advance documentation required. In case of bad weather, landslides or road closures, an alternate sightseeing plan will be arranged.

03

Day 3 — Gangtok City Tour & Transfer to Pelling

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This morning after breakfast, enjoy a half-day city tour of Gangtok covering the Flower Show, Directorate of Handicraft & Handloom (closed Sundays), Do-drul Chorten and Bakthang Falls. Following the sightseeing, transfer to Pelling. Overnight stay in Pelling.

04

Day 4 — Pelling Sightseeing with Skywalk

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After breakfast, set out on a local sightseeing tour covering Rimbi Falls, Khangchendzonga Falls and the sacred Khecheopalri (Wish) Lake. In the afternoon, visit Pemayangtse Monastery, the Rabdantse Ruins and viewpoint, and the Pelling Skywalk, a glass-floored bridge offering panoramic Himalayan views. Return to the hotel. Overnight stay in Pelling.

05

Day 5 — Pelling to Darjeeling

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After breakfast, transfer to Darjeeling. On arrival, check into the hotel and spend the evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Darjeeling.

06

Day 6 — Darjeeling Sightseeing Tour

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Rise early for a 4 AM visit to Tiger Hill to witness the sunrise over Kanchenjunga (subject to permit/token availability), then return to the hotel. After breakfast, set out at 8:30 AM for a city tour covering the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park (closed Thursdays), Tenzing Rock, the Tibetan Refugee Self-Help Centre (closed Sundays), a tea garden (outer view), the Japanese Temple and Peace Pagoda, and Ghoom Monastery. Overnight stay in Darjeeling.

07

Day 7 — Darjeeling to NJP / Bagdogra Departure

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After breakfast, transfer to Bagdogra (IXB) Airport or New Jalpaiguri (NJP) Railway Station for your onward journey.

Visa & Documentation

This is a domestic Indian itinerary; Indian nationals require only a valid government photo ID. Sikkim requires an Inner Line Permit (ILP) for all visitors (and a Protected Area Permit for restricted areas), which Trippova will assist in arranging. Each traveller must carry an original ID (passport / voter ID / driving licence), passport-size photographs, and photocopies of the ID for permit processing.

Payment Terms

- 50% advance at the time of booking confirmation
- Balance 50% due 15 days prior to travel date
- Payments accepted via bank transfer / UPI / card

Cancellation Policy
