- Bouddhanath Stupa & evening aarati at Pashupatinath Temple
- Manakamana Temple en route to Pokhara
- Sunrise views from Sarangkot over the Annapurna & Dhaulagiri ranges
- Devi's Falls, Gupteshwor Cave & Taal Barahi Temple on Phewa Lake
- Swoyambhunath Stupa (Monkey Temple)
- Kathmandu Durbar Square – UNESCO World Heritage Site

A classic Nepal circuit pairing Kathmandu's sacred stupas and temples with the serene lakeside beauty of Pokhara. Highlights include the Bouddhanath Stupa, Pashupatinath Temple, the hilltop Manakamana Temple, sunrise views from Sarangkot and boat rides on Phewa Lake, rounded off with Kathmandu's UNESCO-listed Durbar Square.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Detailed Itinerary

01

Day 1 — Arrival in Kathmandu

Arrive in Kathmandu, where our airport representative will meet, assist and transfer you to your hotel. Enjoy a welcome drink and a briefing on the program. In the evening, visit the Bouddhanath Stupa, one of the largest stupas in the world and a hub of Tibetan Buddhism, followed by the evening aarati at the sacred Pashupatinath Temple on the banks of the Bagmati River. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

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02

Day 2 — Kathmandu to Pokhara

After breakfast, take a scenic drive to Pokhara (approx. 200 km), stopping en route at the hilltop Manakamana Temple, dedicated to the goddess Bhagwati. Check in at your hotel in Pokhara. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

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03

Day 3 — Pokhara Full-Day Sightseeing

Rise early for a drive to Sarangkot (approx. 13 km) to witness a spectacular sunrise over the Annapurna and Dhaulagiri mountain ranges, stopping en route at Bindabasani Temple. After breakfast back at the hotel, spend the rest of the day on a sightseeing tour covering Devi's Falls, Gupteshwor Cave and the lake-island Taal Barahi Temple on Phewa Lake. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

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Day 4 — Pokhara to Kathmandu

After breakfast, drive back to Kathmandu (approx. 200 km, 6-7 hours) and transfer to your hotel. In the evening, visit the Swoyambhunath Stupa, known as the 'Monkey Temple' for its panoramic views over the valley, and explore the UNESCO-listed Kathmandu Durbar Square. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

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Day 5 — Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the international airport in time for your onward departure flight.

Terms, Visa & Booking Policy

Visa & Documentation

Indian nationals do not require a visa to enter Nepal but must carry a valid passport or voter ID card; children under 16 require an original birth certificate and school ID card. Foreign nationals of other nationalities should confirm visa/e-visa requirements before travel.

Payment Terms

- 50% advance at the time of booking confirmation
- Balance 50% due before arrival of the group
- Payments accepted via bank transfer / UPI / card

Cancellation Policy

CANCELLATION WINDOW	CHARGES
30+ days before arrival	50% of deposit forfeited (50% refunded)
15–29 days before arrival	75% of deposit forfeited (25% refunded)
0–14 days before arrival / no-show	100% of deposit forfeited (no refund)

Important Notes

- Quotation is valid for Indian nationality travellers only, for a minimum of 2 Pax.
- Indian currency notes above INR 200 are not accepted in Nepal; carry smaller denomination notes.
- Vehicle follows the mentioned itinerary only; sightseeing changes or additions may incur extra charges.
- Tour confirmation requires 50% advance payment, with full payment due before arrival.
