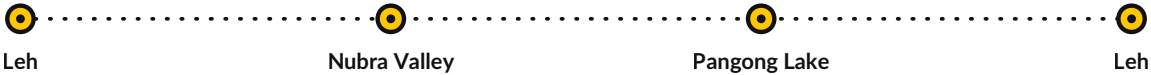

Venture into the high-altitude wonderland of Ladakh, crossing the world's highest motorable passes to reach the golden dunes of Nubra Valley and the shimmering, ever-changing blue of Pangong Lake. This land package blends ancient monasteries, dramatic mountain scenery and true high-altitude adventure across 4 unforgettable nights.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Detailed Itinerary

01

Day 1 — Arrival in Leh & Acclimatization

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Welcome to Leh at 11,650 feet (3,500 m)! On arrival at Kushok Bakula Rinpoche Airport, our local representative will greet you with a traditional khata scarf and transfer you to the hotel. After check-in, relax with tea or coffee and take time to acclimatize to the altitude; you may briefly explore the local market. In the evening, your trip leader will share important tips for high-altitude travel, followed by dinner at the hotel.

02

Day 2 — Leh – Sangam – Hall of Fame – Leh (Sham Valley)

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After breakfast, drive to the western part of Ladakh, visiting Leh Palace for panoramic views of Leh town, and the Hall of Fame, a museum built by the Indian Army. Continue to the Kali Mata Temple at Spituk Monastery, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib and Magnetic Hill, where vehicles appear to defy gravity, before viewing Sangam, the confluence of the Indus and Zaskar rivers. The day ends at Shanti Stupa, offering sweeping views over Leh town. The evening is free to relax and shop at Leh Market. Dinner and overnight stay in Leh.

03

Day 3 — Leh to Nubra Valley via Khardung La Pass

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After breakfast, drive from Leh to Nubra Valley (approx. 126 km, 5-6 hours), crossing Khardung La Pass, the highest all-weather motorable pass in the world, with stops for photos and hot tea at North Pullu. Lunch at Khalsar or Tirth, with optional adventure activities like rafting and ATV rides for the enthusiastic. On reaching Diskit, visit Diskit Monastery and its towering Maitreya Buddha statue, offering beautiful valley views, before heading to Hunder Dunes for a camel ride on the region's unique double-humped camels, found nowhere else in India. Overnight stay in Nubra Valley (approx. 10,000 ft / 3,250 m).

04

Day 4 — Nubra Valley to Pangong Lake and back to Leh

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After breakfast, check out and drive to Pangong Lake (approx. 314 km, 8-10 hours round trip) via Agham and the Shayok Valley, passing small villages en route. Pangong Lake sits at 4,225 metres, is 5-6 km wide and stretches over 135 km, making it the highest saltwater lake in the world, with 25% of its area in India and the rest in China, made famous by Bollywood films such as '3 Idiots'. After lunch by the lakeside, return to Leh via Chang La Pass and Karu Junction, taking in views of the Upper Indus Valley, with an optional stop at Thiksey Monastery or Sindhu Ghat. In the evening, explore Leh's local market before dinner and an overnight stay at the hotel.

05

Day 5 — Departure from Leh

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After breakfast, our team will arrange your transfer to Leh airport as per your flight timings, ensuring a punctual drop-off for your onward journey. Bid farewell to Ladakh with awesome memories of the adventure.

What's Included

- ✔ Comfortable accommodation in a double or twin-sharing room

- ✗ Extra hotel nights required due to cancellations or illness

Terms, Visa & Booking Policy

Visa & Documentation

This itinerary is for domestic Indian travel and does not require a visa for Indian nationals. Inner Line Permits for Nubra Valley and Pangong Lake are arranged by us; foreign nationals require a Protected Area Permit (PAP) and should carry a valid passport, Indian visa and photo ID.

Payment Terms

- 50% advance at the time of booking confirmation
- Balance 50% due 15 days prior to travel date
- Payments accepted via bank transfer / UPI / card

Cancellation Policy

CANCELLATION WINDOW	CHARGES
30+ days before travel	10% of package cost
15–29 days before travel	25% of package cost
7–14 days before travel	50% of package cost
0–6 days before travel / no-show	100% of package cost

Important Notes

- Carry a warm sweater or jacket; it can get cold at Leh airport and on high passes
- Consult your doctor about taking Diamox two days before arrival to help prevent Acute Mountain Sickness (AMS); drink 4-5 litres of water daily and avoid oily foods
- JIO, BSNL and Airtel postpaid connections work in Ladakh; prepaid/roaming SIM cards generally do not
- The Hall of Fame Night Show has an extra transportation charge of approx. ₹800
- Parking is limited in Leh; local transport can be arranged for market visits
- Participants must be fit and aged between 10 and 60 years; smoking and alcohol are not permitted during the tour
- Pack body lotion, sunglasses, warm clothing and dry snacks; lunch may occasionally be skipped as meals are not always available in remote areas
