From the sacred Hadimba Devi Temple and soothing Vashisht Hot Springs to the thrill of Solang Valley and the offbeat charm of Kasol and Manikaran, this trip is built for travellers who want the mountains without the fuss of flights.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Detailed Itinerary

01

Day 1 – Delhi Volvo Pick-up – Overnight to Manali

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In the evening (around 6 pm), you will be picked up from the Delhi bus station (Kashmiri Gate / Majnu ka Tilla) and depart for Manali on an overnight journey by AC Volvo bus. Exotic Manali offers something special for everyone, from peace for meditators to daring activities for adventure seekers, and the journey itself brings a taste of the cool mountain air and serene landscapes to come.

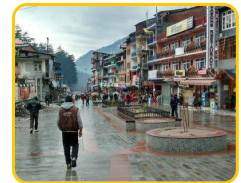
Day 2 – Arrival in Manali – Local City Tour

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Arrive at Manali Volvo stand in the morning, where you will be welcomed and transferred to the hotel. After freshening up, set out on a half-day city tour of Manali covering the holy Hadimba Devi Temple (built in 1553 AD), the Vashisht Hot Springs with their nearby Tibetan monastery, Old Manali's club house area, and time to explore Mall Road and the Ibex Market. Dinner and overnight stay at Manali.

Day 3 – Manali – Solang Valley – Manali

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After breakfast, take an excursion to Solang Valley, admiring the surroundings and enjoying thrilling adventure activities such as horse riding, ATV rides, paragliding, zorbing, zip-lining and bungee jumping at your own cost. In winter, the valley transforms into a snowy playground; onward travel to Atal Tunnel, Dhundi or Sissu depends on weather and road conditions and may need an additional 4x4 cab. Return to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 4 – Manali – Kullu – Naggar / Manikaran

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After breakfast, drive to Kullu, with the option of thrilling river rafting at your own expense, and visit the world-famous Pashmina Shawl Factory and local market. From here, choose between Naggar sightseeing, visiting Naggar Castle and the Roerich Art Gallery, or a trip to Kasol and Manikaran, known for its natural hot springs and the Gurudwara Sahib. Return to Manali for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 5 – Manali – Leisure – Delhi Departure

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After breakfast, check out from the hotel (around 11 am) and enjoy free time for independent activities, shopping at Manali Market and Mall Road. In the evening (around 4 pm), you will be dropped at the Volvo station for your onward overnight journey back to Delhi.

Visa & Documentation

This itinerary is for domestic Indian travel and does not require a visa for Indian nationals. Foreign nationals should carry a valid passport, Indian visa and a government-issued photo ID.

Payment Terms

- Balance amount payable 7 days before the journey

Cancellation Policy

Important Notes

- Children above 6 years are considered a full seat and charged the applicable per-person cost
- Beyond Solang Valley, further movement to Sissu/Atal Tunnel depends on current weather and road conditions and may require an additional 4x4 cab at extra cost
- River rafting at Kullu is available at own expense and is not included in the package cost
