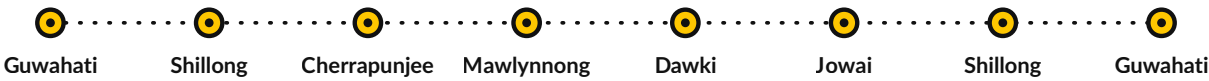

- Laitlumkhrach Canyons – dramatic cliffside viewpoints near Shillong
- Mawphalang Sacred Forest, preserved by the Khasi community
- Cherrapunjee excursion – Nohkalikai Falls & Seven Sister Falls
- Mawlynnong – Asia's cleanest village & Living Root Bridge
- Crystal-clear Umngot River at Dawki
- Overnight in Jowai, headquarters of the Jaintia Hills

The full Meghalaya experience — Laitlumkhrach Canyons, Mawphalang Sacred Forest, Cherrapunjee's waterfalls, Mawlynnong, Dawki and the Jaintia Hills around Jowai. This is the most complete of Trippova's Meghalaya circuits, giving travellers extra time to properly explore the region's canyons, sacred forests and countryside beyond the well-trodden route.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Detailed Itinerary

- 01

Day 1 — Arrive Guwahati

Arrival at Guwahati Airport / Railway Station. Meet & greet and check into the hotel. Evening free for leisure. Overnight stay in Guwahati.

Day 2 — Guwahati to Shillong

After breakfast, drive to Shillong (approx. 130 km / 3 hours), stopping en route at Umium Lake. Check into the hotel, and if time permits, visit Ward's Lake. Overnight stay in Shillong.

Day 3 — Shillong – Laitlumkhrah Canyons & Mawphalang Sacred Forest

After breakfast, visit the Laitlumkhrah Canyons — dramatic cliffsides overlooking deep valleys and distant villages, among the most scenic spots near Shillong. Continue to Mawphalang Sacred Forest, a sacred grove preserved by local tradition for generations, home to rare flora and considered sacred by the Khasi community. Evening return to Shillong. Overnight stay in Shillong.

Day 4 — Shillong to Cherrapunjee

After breakfast, drive to Cherrapunjee (approx. 60 km / 2 hours), visiting the Dwan Syiem View Point, Nohkalikai Falls, Mawsmai Caves, Seven Sister Falls and Eco Park. Check into the hotel. Overnight stay in Cherrapunjee.

Day 5 — Cherrapunjee – Mawlynnong – Dawki – Jowai

After breakfast, drive to Mawlynnong Village — "God's Own Garden" and Asia's cleanest village. Visit the Single Decker Living Root Bridge at Riwei and the natural balancing rock. Continue to Dawki, on the Bangladesh border, to see the crystal-clear Umngot River (optional boat ride available, payable directly to the operator). Later, drive to Jowai, the headquarters of the Jaintia Hills, known for its scenic countryside and waterfalls. Check into the hotel. Overnight stay in Jowai.

Day 6 — Jowai to Shillong

After breakfast, explore Jowai's local sights, including Thadlaskein Lake and nearby waterfalls, subject to time and weather. Later, drive back to Shillong. Evening free for shopping at Police Bazar. Overnight stay in Shillong.

Day 7 — Shillong to Guwahati Airport Drop

After breakfast, drive from Shillong to Guwahati (approx. 100 km / 3 hours), with a drop at Guwahati Airport / Railway Station. Please plan to take an evening flight from Guwahati to allow comfortable travel time. Tour ends with sweet memories of Meghalaya's hills, forests and rivers.

Terms, Visa & Booking Policy

Visa & Documentation

This itinerary is for domestic Indian travel and does not require a visa for Indian nationals. Foreign nationals require a Protected Area Permit (PAP) to visit Meghalaya, and all travellers should carry a valid government-issued photo ID.

Payment Terms

- 50% advance at the time of booking confirmation
- Balance 50% due 15 days prior to travel date
- Payments accepted via bank transfer / UPI / card

Cancellation Policy

CANCELLATION WINDOW	CHARGES
30+ days before travel	10% of package cost
15-29 days before travel	25% of package cost
