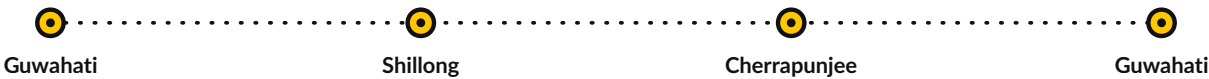

A refreshing introduction to Meghalaya's rolling hills and legendary waterfalls, pairing the cool, café-lined streets of Shillong — the 'Scotland of the East' — with Cherrapunjee, one of the wettest places on earth. Highlights include the dramatic Laitlum Canyons, the spotlessly clean village of Mawlynnong, the crystal-clear Umngot River at Dawki, and Cherrapunjee's cascading Seven Sisters and Nohkalikai Falls.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Detailed Itinerary

01

Day 1 — Guwahati to Shillong

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On arrival at Guwahati Airport or Railway Station, you will be welcomed by our representative and taken to visit the famous Maa Kamakhya Temple on the Nilachal Hills (10 km) — a revered seat of the Tantric cult and one of the 108 Shakti Peethas in the country. Continue the drive to Shillong, stopping en route at Umiam Lake. In the evening, stroll through Shillong's popular Police Bazar. Overnight stay in Shillong.

02

Day 2 — Shillong Local Sightseeing with Laitlum Canyons

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After breakfast, drive out to the Laitlum Canyons for breathtaking valley views. Shillong is known for its clean, steep streets, scenic lakes, parks and dramatic waterfalls, and today's local sightseeing covers notable spots including Wards Lake, Lady Hydari Park, the Don Bosco Museum, Shillong Peak and Elephant Falls. Overnight stay in Shillong.

03

Day 3 — Shillong to Cherrapunjee via Mawlynnong & Dawki

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Start early after breakfast and drive to Mawlynnong, celebrated as the cleanest village in the world — explore its skywalk and the spectacular Living Root Bridge. After lunch, continue to Dawki, the gateway to Bangladesh and a key trading point, via a scenic 45 km drive through deep gorges and ravines. At Dawki, view the crystal-clear Umngot River, the natural boundary between the Jaintia Hills and Khasi Hills, spanned by a single-span suspension bridge. Continue on to Cherrapunjee for an overnight stay.

04

Day 4 — Cherrapunjee Local Sightseeing

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After breakfast, visit Eco Park, Mawsmi Cave, Seven Sisters Falls and Nohkalikai Falls. Following lunch at Cherrapunjee (own arrangement), continue sightseeing at Thangkharang Park and Koh Ramhah before returning to the hotel. Overnight stay in Cherrapunjee. Please note: sightseeing is subject to time available, and waterfalls are at their most spectacular during the monsoon season.

05

Day 5 — Cherrapunjee to Guwahati Departure

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After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Guwahati Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey.

Visa & Documentation

This is a standard domestic Indian itinerary; Indian nationals require only a valid government photo ID, and Meghalaya does not require any special permits for domestic travellers.

Payment Terms

- 50% advance at the time of booking confirmation
- Balance 50% due 15 days prior to travel date
- Payments accepted via bank transfer / UPI / card
